Fufu- I'm working towards writing faster and writing in full sentences.


Aryan- I extremely enjoyed learning about fractions and decimals in Maths.








Ghani- I am able to read better and answer comprehension questions about the book.




Lucas- I have improved my understanding of fractions.

Gurleen- I was able to achieve a better result on my Beep Test.




Seliina- I am able to write grammatically correct sentences.




