ONLINE SESSION for the Year 5/6 Children

Last week, our Family Engagement in Learning Leader (FELL) Yvette Silva organised for the Online Unit of the Police Force to come in to the school and visit our Year 5/6 children. It was a fascinating session and rather eye opening to hear what the police had to say and to hear what some of the children had to say! One of the things that surprised me was the amount of children who use DISCORD - an online chatroom aimed predominantly at adults. While the terms and conditions state you need to be AT LEAST 13 YEARS OLD TO <u>USE DISCORD</u>, many of our children do in fact use it to communicate in groups online after school. We are looking to organise a family information session about Online Safety in the near future, so keep your eye out for information. This might be a great opportunity to ask your child about their online habits and which apps or online portals they use to communicate.
