You may have seen in the news or read in the paper that many schools are finding it challenging at the moment to replace teachers when there are staff absences. This has had an impact on some of our intervention and specialist programs, but the focus has remained on the children's learning. Rena Walsh lead our team through what has been a focus for the sphere of Learning & Teaching and discussed some of our data patterns in relation to reading and mathematics. There has been really pleasing growth with our children who are moving from the "below" to the "At" level of performance in reading and mathematics according to one of our main data sources. The data says that the longer they are at St Mary's, the more improvement they tend to make! We are also looking at the Homework Policy between now and the next meeting.



What are the three states of matter?


What are the properties of solids, liquids and gasses?

Uniforms can be purchased the following ways:


