

Life Education Van - Next Week



From Monday 17th February to Thursday 20th of February all students will be visiting the Life Education Van. Here is what each level will be learning about...

Prep/1	Harold's Friendship explores the qualities of a good friend, feelings and emotions, early warning signs, and safe and unsafe situations.
Year 2	Safety rules investigates safety in a range of situations and environments, people and places to go to for help, and how friends can care for and support each other.
Year 3/4	Mind Your Medicine helps children to explore medicines, how they can help and affect the body and why some people need them
Year 5/6	Relate Respect Connect explores building positive, safe and respectful relationships. It equips students with knowledge, skills and strategies to help them develop safe and respectful relationships - face to face and online.

There will be a parent session between 9 to 9.30 am on Monday 17th of February.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes

CAMPS. SPORTS & EXCURSIONS

FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors, excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works and sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All fou applied for the CSEF at your child's school in 2019, you do not need to complete an application.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary in you not a value means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSET. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- . \$125 for primary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from www.education.vic.gov.au/csef

2019, you do not need to complete an application form in 2020 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

- the following changes have occurred:
 • new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools in 2020 or you
- started or changed schools in 2020 or you did not apply in 2019.

 changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2020.

Check with the school office if you are unsure.
