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Mathematics in the 3/4 Community!

The students of the 3/4 Community have begun the year with an emphasis on Number and Place Value. The students have focused on recognising, modelling, representing and ordering a wide range of numbers. Rearranging and partitioning numbers have also been a strong focus during the early period of Term 1. Beginning the year with this topic is extremely important as nearly all mathematical concepts build on the understanding of Place Value.










Here is a fun and engaging place value game you can play at home:

- 1) Deal each player 3 cards.
- 2) Players use the cards to create the largest 3-digit number possible.
- 3) Players show their cards, and the player with the greatest 3-digit number takes all the cards.
- 4) Play continues with 3 more cards for each player.
- 5) You could easily vary this game to use 2-digit, 4-digit, or even larger numbers.
