As you are aware, the staff did some Professional Learning around different ways to present and analyse Scripture as part of our Closure Day last Friday. Jennifer D'Souza, our Religious Education Leader, took us through using art as a way to look at scripture through a different lens. We looked at the parable of the Good Samaritan and used 2 different images to see different ways in which the parable has been portrayed by artists. It was a wonderful way to look at scripture and also a useful way for the teachers to be able to do the same thing in the classroom with their students.

We then had Amerall Blom, a Religious Consultant from MACS (who used to be on staff here) talk us through using analogies and various graphic maps to help us understand scripture in a different way.

We looked at the Papal Encyclical and looked at a variety of resources for our staff to begin to use as new and different ways to teach RE. It was a wonderful day and a great way to look at our staff formation while also building on our skills to teach RE in a more engaging and collaborative way.
